Nut Free School

Some pupils in our school have a severe allergic reaction to nuts. To minimise risk to these children, Holy Family Junior School is now a NUT FREE SCHOOL. This means nuts, seeds, bars containing nuts or seeds, nutella and peanut butter are not allowed at school.

Healthy food at School

Snacks and lunches are provided for your child at school. Junior Infants will also receive a school lunch from this Monday the 16th of September. Please log in to Carambola regularly to change your child's menu so that he/she doesn't tire of the same food each day. Children are not allowed to have fizzy drinks, crisps, bars, sweets, or gum at school.

Use of pedestrian entrances



Our school campus is very busy with cars, buses and people coming and going all the time. Safety is always our main priority. Thank you for using **only** the pedestrian entrances and walkways.



Park and Stride

You can now <u>PARK AND STRIDE</u> every day to and from school by parking your car in the GLÓR car park for 30 minutes free of charge, while you accompany the children to school.



Safe Routes to School

Reminder: Works on a new School Zone along Friars Walk will begin on **Monday 9**th **of September**. This will result in **some disruption along Friars Walk**. Traffic Management will be in place when required. This may involve the operation of a one-way system on Friars Walk. When this is in operation, traffic will move in the direction of Dunnea Stores only, access will not be possible from Friars Walk onto Station Road/Old Gaol Rd. The scheme will have an approx. works programme of 5 – 6 weeks.



Safe Collection of Children

The safety and welfare of our pupils is of the utmost importance. To ensure the safe handover of each child at home time, your child will only be handed over to you or a named person on the collection sheet. Please send in a note or make a call if there is going to be someone different picking up your child. If there are any changes regarding the collection of your child during the year, please let us know immediately. Thank you for your co-operation. Children must be dropped to school and collected by an adult who is over 18 years of age.

Early Collection of Children

To ensure the safety of all our pupils, when you need to collect your child from school before home time, we ask you to:

- 1. If possible, inform the teacher that morning that you are collecting your child early.
- 2. When you come to collect your child, please go to reception. Your child will be brought to you.
- 3. Sign your child out in our sign out book. This will be in reception.
- 4. On your return, please bring your child back to reception. Please sign the book again.
- 5. He/she will be taken back to class.

Rainy days

As Autumn moves in, please ensure that your child has a coat when coming to school, as he/she may need it while playing outside. Also, please be aware that children are welcomed into school at 9am each morning. On a morning that it is raining try to arrive at this time so that you don't get wet waiting in the rain.



Pupil Personal Accident Insurance

If you wish, you can still avail of Pupil Personal Accident Insurance for your child. The cost of €9 insures your child 24 hours a day, 365 days a year, while €6 insures your child for school activities only. Just fill in the form and send it into your child's class teacher with the money.

Maths at Home

Each month we will send you home a sheet of 'Maths at Home' ideas for you to share with your child. This is a fun and practical way for your child to learn more about Maths in everyday life.
